1. Executive Summary

This report describes the conformance of the Nunney Parish Council website with W3C's Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG). The review process is described in Section 5 below and is based on evaluation described in Accessibility Evaluation Resources.

Based on this evaluation, the Nunney Parish Council website is **close to meeting WCAG 2.1, Conformance Level AA**.

2 Accessibility Statement

Accessibility statement for Nunney Parish Council

Nunney Parish Council is committed to ensuring digital accessibility for people with disabilities. We are continually improving the user experience for everyone, and applying the relevant accessibility standards.

Measures to support accessibility

Nunney Parish Council takes the following measures to ensure accessibility of Nunney Parish Council:

- Assign clear accessibility targets and responsibilities.
- Employ formal accessibility quality assurance methods.
- Conformance status

The Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) defines requirements for designers and developers to improve accessibility for people with disabilities. It defines three levels of conformance: Level A, Level AA, and Level AAA. Nunney Parish Council is partially conformant with WCAG 2.1 level AA. Partially conformant means that some parts of the content do not fully conform to the accessibility standard.

Limitations and alternatives

Despite our best efforts to ensure accessibility of Nunney Parish Council, there may be some limitations. Below is a description of known limitations, and potential solutions. Please contact us if you observe an issue not listed below.

Known limitations for Nunney Parish Council:

PDFs: not all PDFs are produced by the Parish council. Of those which are produced, historic minutes are not going to be brought up to standard unless there is established access need.

If you have any difficulties accessing the content in any PDF documents, please contact us and someone will try as far as is reasonably possible to provide it in an alternative format that you are able to access. Up to and including providing someone to read through them with you.

Visible keyboard focus: links do not visibly change when focused using the keyboard. This is a known problem which we are working to resolve.

Use of headings: we are using too many headings! We know and are working to resolve this.
